

Karate Kamp Covid19 Guidelines

In an effort to follow the same restrictions and requirements allowed by the CDC and Governor Lamont to assure a safe environment and enjoyable time for all campers, the following provisions will need to be followed:

- Currently in Phase 2 of the CDC Guidelines, Outdoor events can be held with no more than 100 people.
- **Masks will not need to be worn while doing your module sessions on Saturday.** Social distancing can be controlled in these settings by the instructor. Depending on the number of students and ranks, module set ups will be determined at a later date but will follow the current CDC guidelines.
- **At any other time**, a mask must be worn by everyone in **any area** away from their camping site.
- Social Distancing of 6 feet must be kept as much as possible. If you cannot seem to be 6 feet away, you must have a mask on.
- **All campers should plan on bringing with them Lysol or some type of disinfecting wipes and hand sanitizer.**
- Currently at the campground, bathrooms and showers are limited to only 2 people in at a time.
- Anticipation of food being served from the kitchen using an order form to ensure compliance social distancing.

Please note, that as the new Phase begins to open for Connecticut, these guidelines are subject to change and will be updated as frequently as possible.
